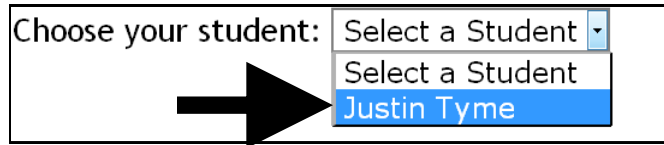




1. Once you are logged in, select your student from the dropdown menu.
